SOUTH GRAND ART REHABILITATION; ST. LOUIS, MO - 2014

After the Michael Brown non-indictment news was released many St. Louisans took to the streets in peaceful protest. A handful of people decide to protest in violence throwing bricks into local vendors windows shattering many of the windows along Grand Avenue. In the flowing days, the Alderman of the Tower Grove neighborhood called local artist to help restore a sense of normalcy to the community by painting on the boarded up windows. To help contribute I painted two large images in hope that we could reach out to our community and start a meaningful productive dialogue. The first painting was of two hands one black and one white clasping together as an extension of the arch. The second painting was of a baby crying out with an empty chalkboard painted dialogue bubble amplifying from his mouth giving anyone in the community a chance to share with each other thoughts and emotions during that difficult time.
