Fair St. Louis Mural, 1999, 14' x 48', Sullivan Blvd.,
This mural was commissioned by Whitaker Homes to show the St. Louis sports celebrities of that time. It was created in three days in front of 1.8 million viewers attending Fair St. Louis.

J Bucks Restaurant Clayton location, 2013, 30" x55'
J Bucks Restaurant desired a full room mural depicting special homegrown celebrities from St. Louis. The art was created on canvas and installed at the restaurant. This was created in two weeks. \$8,000

Corvette Tribute, STL250 celebration.
This painting was created on one of the 250 STL cakes scattered around the St. Louis region. The image was designed to celebrate the manufacturing of the Corvette in St. Louis.

This is only one scene in a series at this location. A great example of trompe l'oeil illustration, this wall was once flat and white. All details including bricks and trim were painted to create the building. Series of scenes, \$80,000

This is a conceptual design for the Kingman, AZ Route 66 organization. The design was to be illustrated on a highly visible wall on Route 66. The project was bid at \$12,000.

Helen Fitzgerald's Restaurant. This ninety-five foot wide patriotic mural was created June 2015. It was a recreation of a mural painted to commemorate September 11th. \$11,000

Classic Road Show, Midwest Truckport, Cuba, MO. This scene is one section of a continuous 250' painting.

This vintage auto mural was one wall of a surround 250' transportation painting. The art showed classic cars, trains, trucks and delivery vehicles. It took eight weeks to complete. \$20,000.

Mural at the Four-Way. This is one of several murals I have completed in Cuba, MO. Cuba has been named Mural City by the Missouri legislature due to their mural program. This specific triptych depicts the community involvement of Bill Wallis. Thirty-feet wide. \$8,500

City of Champions, J Bucks Restaurant Downtown location, acrylic on stretched canvas, 4' x 16'.

This painting was one of a sports triptych. Each of the three scenes was completed in the same size. This depicts the Cardinals; the second depicted the Bleus and Rams while the third showed the highlights from the 2011 World Series Game 6. \$7,500
